#### **KINDER READINESS PROGRAM**

Do you know anyone with children who will be turning 4 years old between 1 January and 30 April 2020? If so, please spread the word about our Kinder Readiness Program.

This program:

- fills the 'gap' for children who may be too mature for a three-year-old program but aren't quite ready for four-year-old kinder (children who turn four between 1st January and 30th April).
- provides opportunities to develop social skills and engage with peers of a similar age in two 2.5-hour sessions per week.
- helps children to develop a sense of connectedness and belonging in a large group setting.
- is run by a Bachelor-qualified teacher and Diplomaqualified co-educator.

"Our March born child wasn't ready for 4-year-old kinder but seemed much older than the children attending the 3-year-old program. The Kinder Readiness program allowed him to learn with children his own age. He's now well placed to thrive when he goes to school rather than just keep up. ### BUSH KINDER – A FIRST FOR BEACONSFIELD KINDER

We are very excited to announce the first of our Bush Kinder sessions took place on 29<sup>th</sup> April. The children from our Emerald group absolutely loved it!

For those not familiar with the Bush Kinder program, this is where kinder education for children is held outdoors, allowing children to engage in a variety of activities in a natural setting not typically available in a traditional kinder setting.

As part of the Bush Kinder program, children visit various local locations including Wilson Botanic Park and Akoonah Park for one kinder session each week. Whatever the weather, children are encouraged to play, explore and learn in a bush or natural environment. Physical activity is encouraged, and the children and adults' benefit from using only what nature has provided.

At Beaconsfield Kindergarten, we want to give children a chance to spend quality time in nature with passionate teachers to encourage them to explore and learn. Learning in nature invigorates the senses, stimulates the imagination and nourishes wellbeing. By exploring nature, building cubby houses, climbing trees, splashing in puddles and playing games, the children are learning with their whole bodies.

A massive thank you and well done to Emerald Group's Jeanette Bartlett and team and Sapphire Group's Jolene O'Halloran and team for having the passion to make Bush Kinder a reality in 2019. We look forward to seeing how the program grows and develops in years to come.

#### **CAR PARKS – O'NEIL ROAD AND WOODS STREET CENTRES**

Please closely supervise children at all times when in the car park, and encourage them to cross only at designated crossing points. Please remember that it is strictly prohibited to leave children in cars while picking up/dropping off.

Please do not use the disabled car parks out the front of kinder unless you are displaying a disabled pass. Also, at Woods St please refrain from parking in the reserved car parks as these are for staff parking. If you are staying for kinder duty please collect a parking permit from staff.

#### SO WHY ALL THIS FUNDRAISING?

Did you know our kinder is one of only a few Committee-run kindergartens in the Casey and Cardinia shire areas? This means that we don't receive any additional support from outside sources.

While government funding covers the basic costs of our 4yo programs, our Kinder Readiness and 3yo programs currently don't receive any funding. With this in mind, in addition to fees and grants, our kinder relies heavily on the support of families through fundraising to ensure we keep our kinder running as wonderfully as it does with great resources.

Fundraising not only helps with key items such as toys, books, games and play equipment, it also helps fund key facility upgrades such as landscaping works and ongoing maintenance.

So, with our kids in mind, we really appreciate your continued support and help in all our fundraising activities. Beaconsfield Kinder really is a community kinder, and we thank you for being such an essential part of that community.

### FUNDRAISING - TOTAL YEAR-TO-DATE

Thank you all so much for your incredible support for our fundraising efforts year to date. We are so pleased that from our term one and term two fundraising activities we have raised \$3,916 which is a great step towards our overall goal of \$15,000 for the year.



#### **TERM TWO FUNDRAISERS**

**Entertainment Books** - Your children would have all been sent home with one of these books which you are able to purchase for \$70.
